WHEREAS, on July 14, 2026, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba adopted Resolution No. 2026-52 formally approving the Classification System – Basic Salary / Hourly Schedule and the Elected Officials Classification System Basic Salary Schedule, effective July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2026-52 incorporated negotiated cost of living adjustments (COLAs) and Board approved classification and compensation adjustments effective for the applicable fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County's is transitioning from a monthly payroll cycle to a biweekly payroll cycle effective September 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the biweekly payroll cycle requires amendments to the adopted salary schedules to reflect biweekly salary rates consistent with the County's payroll practices; and

WHEREAS, the Classification System – Basic Salary / Hourly Schedule currently reflects monthly salary rates and hourly rates and must be amended to replace monthly salary rates with biweekly salary rates while retaining hourly rates; and

WHEREAS, the Yuba County Elected Official Classification System – Basic Salary Schedule currently reflects monthly salary rates and must be amended to replace monthly salary rates with biweekly salary rates; and

WHEREAS, this amendment is administrative in nature and does not modify the compensation levels, salary ranges, classifications, negotiated COLAS, or other compensation provisions previously approved by the Board of Supervisors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba hereby resolved as follows:

1. Amendment to Classification System – Basic Salary / Hourly Schedule. Effective September 1, 2026, the Classification System – Basic Salary / Hourly Schedule adopted by Resolution No. 2026-52 is amended to replace monthly salary rates with biweekly salary rates and retain hourly rates.
2. Amendment to the Yuba County Elected Official Classification System – Basic Salary Schedule adopted by Resolution No. 2026-52 is amended to replace monthly salary rates with biweekly salary rates.
3. The amendment approved herein is solely to update the salary schedule format and payroll frequency. Nothing contained in this resolution shall be construed as changing the compensation levels, negotiated COLAs, salary ranges, classifications, or fiscal year budget changes previously approved by the Board through Resolution No. 2026-52.
4. Continued Effect of Resolution No. 2026-52. Except as expressly amended herein, all provisions of Resolution No. 2026-52 remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Classification System – Basic Salary/Hourly Schedule attached hereto as “Attachment A” and the Yuba County Elected Officials – Basic Salary Schedule attached hereto as “Attachment B” are hereby adopted in their entirety and shall become effective September 1, 2026.
